DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal The 2011 Gypsy Moth Eradication Project, involves application of the insecticide *Bacillus thuringiensis* var. *kurstaki*, and project monitoring utilizing pheromone baited traps during the summers of 2011 and 2012.
