**Section 1: LICENSE INFORMATION**

- **Applicant:** Name address and contact information for the company submitting the application.
- **Tonnage Contact:** Name address and contact information for the individual responsible for reporting tonnage.
- **Physical Location of Facility:** Include both the mailing and physical address of the facility being licensed.

**Section 2: DISTRIBUTION INFORMATION**

- Check the box that is applicable for the following:
  - Initial Distributor means a person who first distributes a commercial feed in or into Washington State.
  - Company Name Appears on Label as Guarantor means a company responsible for the product.
  - Manufacturer means to grind, mix or blend, or further process a commercial feed for distribution.
  - Types of Feed the Physical Location Distributes: Indicate with a check mark the type(s) of commercial feed distributed or manufactured in Washington State.
- **Examples of Feed Ingredients by Category:**
  - ◆ **Bakery Product, Dried; Bakery Waste:** Dried bread, cookies, cakes, crackers, flours and doughs.
  - ◆ **Distiller Grain By-Products:** Dried distiller grains and wet distiller grains.
  - ◆ **Other Grain Products & Grain By-Products:** Wheat millrun; corn gluten meal; brewers dried grains; malt sprouts; wheat middlings; bran products.
  - ◆ **Fats and Oils:** Animal, vegetable, blends; restaurant grease; "yellow grease".
  - ◆ **Plant Protein Products:** Soybean meal; canola meal; cottonseed meal; pea by-products; yeast products.
  - ◆ **Prohibited Animal Protein Products:** (BSE Rule) Meat & Bone Meal; animal by-product meal; meat meal; bone meal; chondroitin sulfate; and distressed or salvage pet food. In addition, any product labeled with the BSE cautionary statement "Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants" is a prohibited material.
  - ◆ **Other Animal Protein Products:** Blood meal; pure pork protein; pure horse protein; poultry meal; hydrolyzed feather meal; fish meal; whey and other milk products.
  - ◆ **Roughage /Forage Products:** Soybean hulls and millrun; cottonseed hulls; beet pulp; dehydrated alfalfa meal, ground alfalfa hay; ground grass.
  - ◆ **Vitamin I Mineral Premixes:** Individual, multiple vitamins or vitamin precursor mixes; mineral blocks; premixes; limestone; deflourinated phosphate.
  - ◆ **Other:** Molasses; fermentation products; special purpose products; non-protein nitrogen; screenings; chaff; and dust.

- Each licensee must pay the application fee of \$50.00 for each facility and/or location.

**OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

A license is not required to distribute pet food and specialty pet food in Washington. However, all pet food and specialty pet food products must be registered. Forms necessary to register pet food and specialty pet food can be found at <http://agr.wa.gov/PestFert/Forms/default.htm>.

Products labeled as both feed and fertilizer also require fertilizer registration. If distributed in bulk, a bulk fertilizer distribution license is also required. Fertilizer registration and licensing forms can be found at <http://agr.wa.gov/PestFert/Forms/default.htm>.
