RE: PIROPLASMOSIS HORSES FROM TEXAS TO WASHINGTON

Any horse entering Washington State from Texas must be accompanied by a valid entry permit number and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Any horse originating from Kleberg County in Texas must be negative to a C-ELISA test for Piroplasmosis within thirty days before entry into Washington State, and must be quarantined upon arrival and retested within sixty to ninety days. Horses that test positive on the post-arrival C-ELISA test are not permitted to remain in the state and must be removed.
