IMPORTANT NOTICE TO APPLICANT

- A Grade "A" bulk milk transport tanker must comply with the requirements of WAC 16-125-120 and Chapter 15.36 RCW.
- In case the Director discovers the violation of any item of sanitation, a second inspection shall be made to determine compliance with the requirements of these chapters. Any violation of the same requirement on such re-inspection shall call for immediate condemnation of the tanker and result in the degrading of any milk being transported in it and may result in the suspension or revocation of the Milk Transport Company License.
- Such a license may be temporarily suspended by the director upon violation of any terms of this chapter, or interference with the Director in the performance of his duties, or revoked after an opportunity for a hearing by the Director upon serious or repeated violations.
