DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal The 2007 Gypsy Moth Eradication Project, involves application of the insecticide *Bacillus thuringiensis* var. *kurstaki*, and project monitoring utilizing pheromone baited traps during the summers of 2007 and 2008.

Proponent Washington State Department of Agriculture

Location of proposal, including street address, if any King County, Washington, (S24 T22N R4E) Boundaries: The site is in the city of Kent. The approximate center of the 25-acre proposed treatment site is on Washington Avenue, midway between Willis Street and Mecker Street.

Lead agency Washington State Department of Agriculture
