



ASPARAGUS PESTICIDES - 2010

This sheet lists some pesticides used on asparagus. The health symptoms listed may be caused by things other than pesticides. If you feel sick after exposure to pesticides, contact a doctor or clinic. If a person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, give artificial respiration.

If you are exposed to a pesticide spray or drift:

- Leave the area
- Tell your employer
- Immediately rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes
- If you get pesticides in your eyes, hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. If you wear contacts, rinse for 5 minutes, remove contacts and continue rinsing eyes.
- Change into clean clothes
- Always wash work clothes separately from other clothes

If you feel sick while working with pesticides:

- Leave the area
- Tell your employer you feel sick, start first aid if needed
- Go to a doctor or clinic
- Have someone go with you
- Tell the doctor the pesticide name. Your employer must provide this information
