SUBJECT: USDA, APHIS Administrative Fees for Phytosanitary Certificates

Please be aware that the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (USDA, APHIS) will begin phasing in the administrative fees shown below for all phytosanitary certificates in October. These fees are in addition to any fees and/or charges currently assessed for phytosanitary certification services.

Effective October 1, 2009 all Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) programs that issue phytosanitary certificates <u>outside</u> of the Phytosanitary Certificate Issuance and Tracking System (*PCIT*) will be required to assess, collect, and remit to USDA, APHIS the *non-PCIT* fees shown below for <u>each</u> certificate issued. Any certificate that is re-issued due to errors made by the applicant is also subject to the administrative fees. There is no administrative fee for certificates re-issued due to errors made by the Authorized Certification Official (ACO).

The administrative fees for phytosanitary certificates generated using *PCIT* are billed directly to the applicant by APHIS and are one-half the *non-PCIT* rate.

USDA Fee Effective October 1, 2009 – *PCIT*/\$3.00, non-PCIT/\$6.00 USDA Fee Effective October 1, 2010 – *PCIT*/\$6.00, non-PCIT/\$12.00

WSDA encourages applicants to take advantage of *PCIT*.
